

**Title:** Assistant Professor (Geotechnical Engineering)

**Position Summary:**

The School of Civil, Environmental and Infrastructure Engineering (SoCEIE) at SIU Carbondale invites applications for a full-time, continuing, tenure track faculty position in the area of Geotechnical Engineering at the rank of Assistant Professor.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Teach undergraduate and graduate level courses as assigned by the school director.
- Actively participate in the senior design course.
- Develop an externally funded research program in her/his area of research. The school provides support and excellent opportunities for the development of new faculty.
- Carry out research and supervise the work of M.S., M.E., and Ph.D. students.
- Actively participate in scholarly activities by publishing the results of her/his research in peer-reviewed journals and conference proceedings.
- Collaborate with other faculty on research and professional development activities
- Provide service to the school, college, university, and profession. This includes participation in international and national professional society activities.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

Applicants must have an undergraduate degree in Civil Engineering or a closely related engineering field and an earned doctorate in Civil Engineering or a closely related engineering field with a specialization in the area of Geotechnical Engineering by August 15, 2024.

Applicants must have a demonstrated potential for high-quality research documented by publications and funded projects, and high-quality teaching for undergraduate and graduate courses in general Civil, Environmental and Infrastructure Engineering fields.

In addition, professional engineer licensure is desirable and will be required for tenure.

**Preferred Qualifications:**

Special consideration will be given to applicants with professional practice experience in industry and/or academia.

**General Information:**

Applicants must submit a cover letter which clearly describes the candidate's qualifications for the position, a complete vita, a teaching statement (maximum 2 pages), and a research statement (maximum 2 pages). Both statements should be uploaded as document type "other" in the application system.
